- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.30 is required to be eligible for admission, however it does not guarantee admission. Admission is based on successful completion of all required courses, cumulative grade point average (GPA) and faculty review of an electronic portfolio of work completed in JCCC studios. Applicants must have grades of C or better in all non-studio-based courses with grades of B or better in studio-based courses. Placement is also based on available space.
